Year Founded: 1978

Legal Name of the Corporation: Nevada City Community Broadcast Group, Inc.

Mission: KVMR entertains, informs, and challenges its listeners with a diverse mix of music, news, opinion, and information. The station seeks to improve its listeners' lives with timely, relevant, and engaging programming. KVMR gives voice to the community and celebrates the music of the world.

Composition of the Board of Directors: Twelve (12) seats, including four (4) seats elected by KVMR volunteers and eight (8) seats elected by the Board of Directors. In addition, the KVMR General Manager serves as a non-voting member of the Board.

Terms of office: Three (3) years, with a maximum of two consecutive terms. Terms begin on October 1, concurrent with the beginning of the KVMR fiscal year.

Election Calendar: Applications are due no later than thirty (30) days prior to the September General Meeting (for volunteer-elected seats) or the September Board meeting (for board-elected seats). Earlier submission is encouraged.

Standing Board Committees: Executive Committee, Financial Review Committee, Board Development Committee, Station Development Committee, Fund Development Committee

Annual Budget: Approximately \$900,000

- Fulfill a complete three-year term of office

I understand that the qualifications of an effective Board member include:

- A minimum of 2 years of experience in a non-profit organization, which may include experience as a board member, committee member, or the equivalent.
- Basic fluency with financial reports.
- Experience working effectively in small teams.
- Familiarity with KVMR By-Laws, policies, and a working knowledge of the KVMR Board process.

I understand that the process for consideration and election as a Board member includes the following:

- Comply with deadlines set forth by Board Development Committee
- Submit Director Application (this document).
- Attend a KVMR Board Meeting (strongly encouraged)
- Attend a Board Development Interview.
- Attend a General Meeting or Board Meeting for Election (depending on the board seat being sought)
- Submit KVMR Board member agreement (after election)
